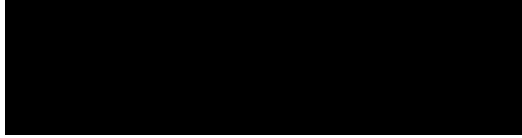

SUBJECT. SAFETY CONCERN 88.146

A meeting to discuss your concern was held on December 09, 1988. Present were: Doug Smith, 371 Building Manager, Gene McCracken, [REDACTED], and Steve Cordova.

Doug Smith will take measures to correct the uncontrolled storage of drums, coffins, and crates. Any employee having problems with storage of these items should contact Doug Smith directly. Crates that are open and not sealed will remain in a room with SAAM alarm coverage. Crates that have been nailed down and properly sealed will be allowed outside to be moved A.S.A.P. Gene McCracken will meet with Ginzzie Aguero to discuss the storage problem.

The drum committee has discussed purchasing a more compact air mover to help the storage problem. Doug Smith will talk to J.A. Jones regarding equipment storage, as well as Mtce. storage of equipment. We feel these accomplishments should resolve your safety concern.
