LACK OF MEDICAL SURVEILLANCE

The Joint Company/Union Safety Committee (JCUSC) has investigated the subject safety with the following results:

Dr. Furman, Occupational Health, explained that the medical department was interested in having accessible records of employees exposed to health hazards.

Currently, lab workers are being identified in the Med-Vax system under Medical Surveillance section. This information will provide the Medical Department with the work location and job titles of employees. Also, the Med-Vax system will have access to building hazard inventories, the supervisor's description of jobs and any comments of hazardous exposure the employee wished to enter in file.

The Medical Department routinely performs examinations to identify health effects in the body systems such as blood, kidney, and liver. At any time, the laboratory worker develops symptoms they feel could be related to work exposure, they can be medically evaluated at any time. These workers should report their medical problems to the Occupational Health Department.

Changes to this agreement cannot be made without concurrence by the JCUSC. If you have additional problems with this concern, the resolution, or the implementation of the corrective actions, please contact the JCUSC. Thank you for participating in the safety concern process.

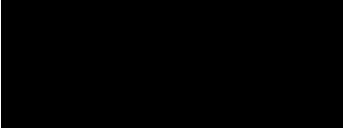


