

Subject: 2000-037 Barrel Closure Rings.

On 7-13-00 I performed a walkdown to verify the agreed upon resolutions that resulted in signing off as satisfied with Management's reply to the above noted concern. During the walkdown I noted a majority of drums had been rotated as required to meet the agreement, approximately 60 MT drums had been relocated to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. It is important to note that the agreed upon actions did not include POC drums as handling them again would pose an even more unsafe condition than the original concern.

As agreed to in conversation with J. Kunkel and C. Padilla the following actions should continue to take place regarding drum storage whenever possible:

All drums with the exception of POC's should have the closure ring towards the wall and not the hallway whenever possible during drum storage/movement.

This technique to remove the hazard from the aisleways will be communicated by Supervision via toolboxes and pre-ev briefs.

I am hoping that you agree that this satisfactorily closes out concern 2000-037.
