

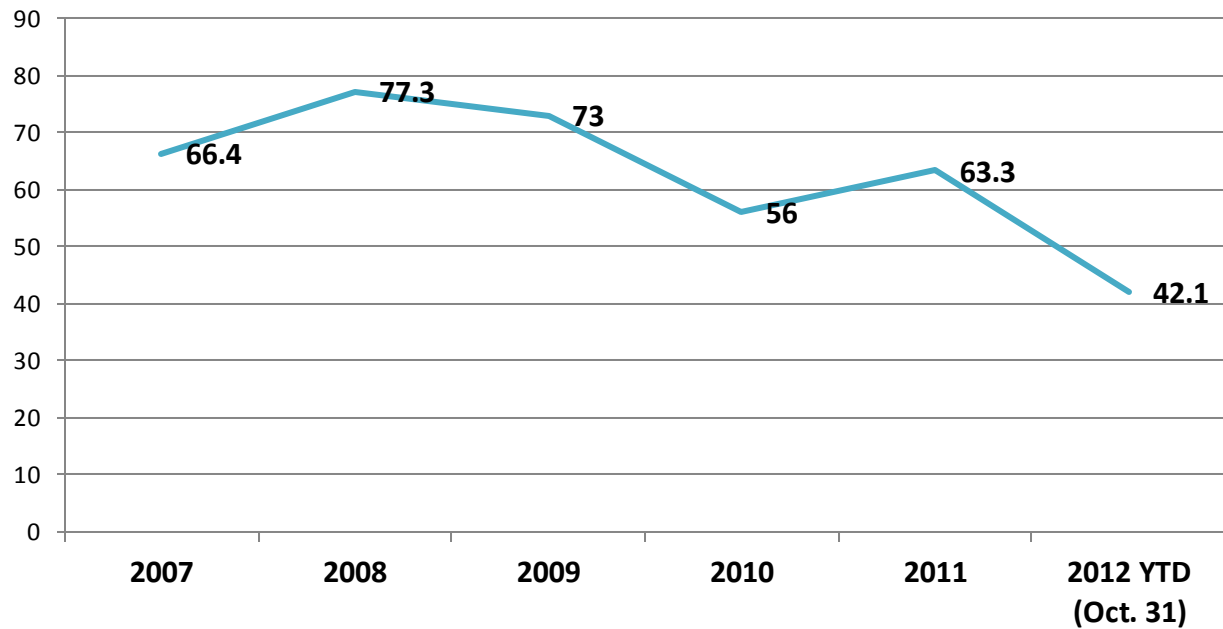

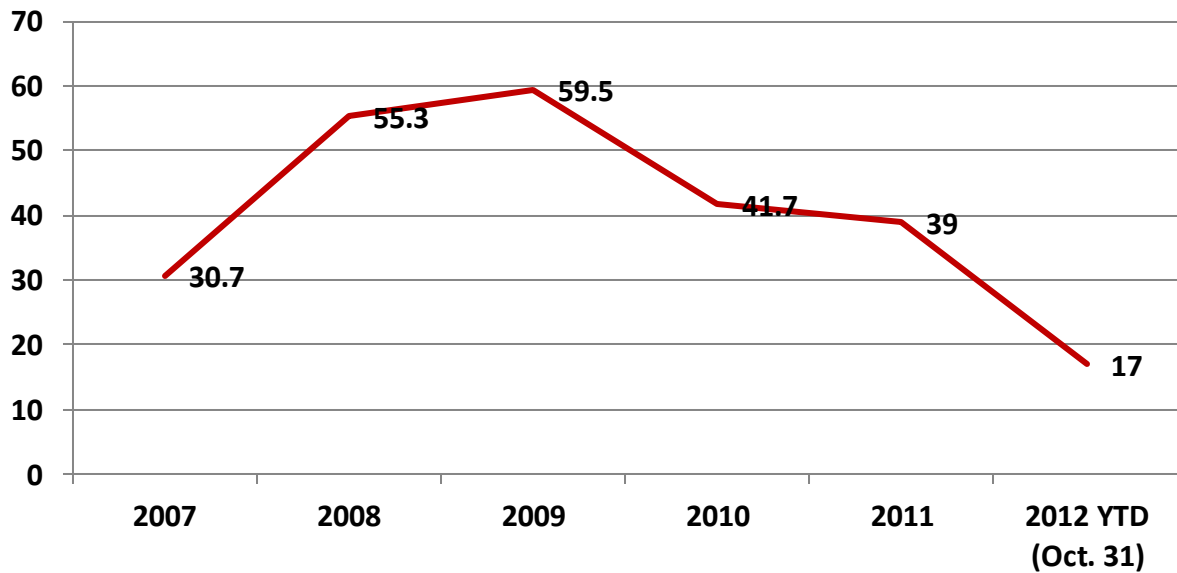

The percentages were calculated from numbers taken from DOL's website. You will notice that some of the percentages are for more than 100%. This is because the numbers used are not tracking the same claims but are instead reporting the claims filed and paid within the same month. It takes about 6 months for a claim to work its way through the system. Because DOL will not release the historical statistics to EECAP the only way we can figure the percentages paid is by assuming there is not much fluctuation in the number of claims filed and paid each month. In a state where there are very few claims being filed and paid for the year this can lead to a situation where there could be more claims paid than filed; hence the percentages over 100%.
